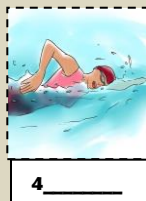

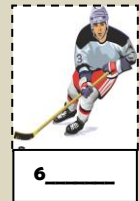

**Do-** para los deportes individuales que NO terminan en -ing y con los deportes de combate incluso si terminan en -ing

**Ejemplos: Do** karate, **do** boxing, **do** gymnastics.
